



Construction Laborer Job Description

Tasks

Measure, mark, or record openings or distances to layout areas where construction work will be performed.

Clean or prepare construction sites to eliminate possible hazards.

Installation of siding, roofs, windows, doors, sheetrock, flooring, framing, trim, cabinetry and plumbing/lighting fixtures

Demolition of home interiors, siding, and roofs

Dig ditches or trenches, backfill excavations, or compact and level earth to grade specifications, using picks, shovels, pneumatic tampers, or rakes

Load, unload, or identify building materials, machinery, or tools, distributing them to the appropriate locations

Erect or dismantle scaffolding, shoring, braces, traffic barricades, ramps, or other temporary structures

Perform building weatherization tasks, such as repairing windows, adding insulation, or applying weather-stripping materials

Mop, brush, or spread paints, cleaning solutions, or other compounds over surfaces

Apply caulking compounds by hand or caulking guns

Additional Information:

Previous construction experience is preferred

Must be able to lift over 50 pounds
